# MINUTES OF September 16, 2016 BOARD MEETING CENTRAL TEXAS GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT

President Felps established a quorum through a roll call of Directors; declared a quorum present; and called the Meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

President Felps then asked for public comment. There was no public comment.

President Felps then asked for consideration and/or action on Minutes of the Regular Board Meeting held August 19, 2016.

Bill Luedecke moved to:

Approve the Minutes of the Regular Board Meeting held August 19, 2016.

Second was by Steve Henderson.

Vote on the motion carried.

President Felps then asked for consideration and/or action on Expenditures for August 2016; Review of 2015-2016 Budget; Budget Line Item Adjustments.

Steve Henderson moved to:

Approve the Expenditures for August 2016.

Second was by Wayne Brown.

Vote on the motion carried.

President Felps then asked for consideration and/or action on Resolutions Providing for the Sale of Property Acquired by the Burnet Central Appraisal District at Delinquent Tax Sale.

Steve Henderson moved to:

Approve Resolutions Providing for the Sale of Property Acquired by the Burnet Central Appraisal District at Delinquent Tax Sale.

Second was by Wayne Brown.

Vote on the motion carried.

President Felps then asked for Certification of Unopposed Candidates for the Election scheduled to be held on November 8, 2016. As the authority responsible for having the official ballot prepared, Election Officer, Donnita Coats, certified that the following candidates were unopposed for election to office for the election scheduled to be held on November 8, 2016.

### Wayne Brown moved to:

Accept the Certification of Unopposed Candidates for the Election scheduled to be held on November 8, 2016 as presented.

Second was by Steve Henderson.

Vote on the motion carried.

President Felps then asked for consideration and/or action on Cancellation of the November 8, 2016 Election.

# Wayne Brown moved to:

Cancel the November 8, 2016 Election that was ordered for the purpose of Electing Director, At-Large; Director, Precinct 1; and Director, Precinct 3 for the Central Texas Groundwater Conservation District.

Second was by Steve Henderson.

Vote on the motion carried.

President Felps then asked for consideration and/or action on TML Multistate IEBP Insurance ReRates. General Manager Shell informed the Board that the District is waiting on revised rerates from TML that are estimated to show a 6% increase which has been included in the proposed 2016-2017 Budget.

President Felps then asked for consideration and/or action on a TML IRP Board of Trustees Election Ballot. General Manager Shell reviewed the ballot, the Board made selections, President Felps executed the ballot and directed General Manager Shell to send the ballot to TML.

President Felps then asked for consideration and/or action on a Proposed FY 2016-2017 Budget for the District. General Manager Shell presented and reviewed a proposed FY 2016-2017 Budget that was created as a result of discussions at the August 5, 2015 Special Board Meeting.

#### Bill Luedecke moved to:

Adopt the Proposed FY 2016-2017 Budget, as presented, as the FY 2016-2017 Budget of the District. Second was by Steve Henderson.

Vote on the motion carried.

President Felps then asked for consider and/or action on a 2016 Proposed Tax Rate. General Manager Shell informed the Board that the previously approved and noticed proposed tax rate of \$0.0091/\$100 for a total tax of \$472,200.00 would increase revenue by \$20,155.00 compared to 2015.

Bill Luedecke moved to:

Approve a Minute Order adopting a Tax Rate for the Year 2016. Pursuant to Chapter 8810, Texas Special District Local Laws Code, the District hereby adopts a 2016 Tax Rate of 0.0091/\$100 value. THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.

Second was by Steve Henderson.

Vote on the motion carried.

President Felps then asked for consideration and/or action on Determination of the Drought Stage. Asst. General Manager/Hydrologist Sodek reported that the District had record rainfall in the month of August and that groundwater levels are high for this time of year. However, September has been dry and there is no forecast for cold fronts or rainfall so he recommended staying at the current Drought Stage 1 - Near Normal at this time. No action was taken to change the current Drought Stage.

President Felps then called on the General Manager for the General Manager and/or Staff Report.
